All the tall reedy, sedges, grasses etc:

Glyceria maxima - Reed Sweet Grass
Schoenoplectus lacustris (Scirpus) - Great Club Rush
Carex pendula - Pendulous Sedge
Carex paniculata - Great Tussock Sedge
Carex riparia - Greater Pond Sedge
Carex acutiformis - Lesser Pond Sedge
Carex pseudocyperus - Cyperus Sedge
Cyperus longus - Galingale
Phragmites communis - Common Reed
Iris pseudacorus - Yellow Flag Iris
Sparganium erectum - Burr Reed
Phalaris arundinacea - Reed Canary Grass
